



## House Teams at Martlesham Primary Academy.

All pupils and staff are allocated a house team when they join our school. House points are awarded when pupils demonstrate good learning behaviours but also for good conduct around our school. The houses are led by the House Captains and the Vice House Captains. The children are elected into these posts at the start of the academic year after they have delivered election speeches to their houses. All pupils and staff then vote for their leader. Their role is to lead by example and motivate and inspire their house team. Each week house points are collected and the totals are revealed in our Butterfly Book Assembly. House Captains give motivational speeches and set targets for their teams for the following week. In addition to this we have House Team discussion on school issues and we raise key issues and find solutions to further improve our school.

Each half term the House Captains prepare challenges for the children in school. These range from spelling competitions to bake off events. The children love taking part in these and we see outstanding examples of collaboration.
