Holly Blues	Choose an endangered animal to draw or paint. Find out where it lives and why it is endangered.	Collect some 'Amazing animal facts' about fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals! Which animals are the fastest, heaviest and strongest? Write down the most exciting facts!
Adonis Blues	Look at images of Anglo-Saxon coins. Can you design a coin? You could draw a picture or use modelling clay or other materials to make your coin look like metal. Use your imagination!	Visit your local library/Do some research and find out about any Viking invasions in your local area or county (please just look at Viking invasions as this links to our learning at this point).
Silver Studded Blues	So far, 24 astronauts have visited the Moon. Find out their names, download pictures and record interesting facts about them.	Design and create an astronaut space helmet or alien headwear using junk materials. Bring it to school and take part in a space-inspired fashion parade!
