Subject	Task	Resources to Support
Science	 Test the rates at which liquids flow (viscosity) down a ramp or sloping piece of guttering. Time how long it takes for five different fluids to reach the bottom. Your selection might include lemonade, oil, double cream, washing up liquid, treacle and ketchup. Decide what to measure and identify the factors that would make it a fair test. Record results using diagrams, tables and charts. 	A fair test is a test which controls all but one variable when attempting to answer a scientific question. Only changing one variable allows the person conducting the test to know that no other variable has affected the results of the test. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ubGxkWWWilg — A similar experiment being carried out.
	You will need to provide children with a stopwatch, tape measure and a ramp or guttering for testing.
