<u>Paragraph 1</u> <b>Potion/ plan</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What will the potion do?</li> <li>• How does the potion smell?</li> <li>• How does the potion taste?</li> <li>• How does the potion look?</li> <li>• Does it make a magical noise when the cork is removed?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tiny blue bottle</li> <li>• Put Juliet in a deep sleep for two days – to make it look like she is dead.</li> <li>• 'fall into a sleep as deep as death'</li> </ul>		
<u>Paragraph 2</u> <b>Plan to stop the marriage/ give Romeo and Juliet their future together</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is the plan?</li> <li>• Who has what job/parts to do?</li> <li>• How will the potion from Friar Lawrence help Juliet?</li> <li>• Who knows the plan?</li> <li>• Those that do not know the plan, are there any consequences for this?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Juliet gets put in the Capulet tomb because they think she is dead.</li> <li>• Once she wakes, she can secretly go to her lover Romeo in Mantua.</li> <li>• Friar Lawrence's job to tell Romeo of the plan.</li> <li>• Juliet's job is to drink the potion 'tonight'</li> <li>• Romeo's job is to stay where he is and wait for the letter.</li> <li>• Friar Lawrence and Juliet know about the plan. Hoping to tell Romeo before he hears the news of her death and reacts.</li> <li>• Benvolio doesn't know the plan and so doesn't stop to collect the very important letter for Romeo. He is more concerned about how he will take the news of Juliet's death.</li> </ul>		
<u>Paragraph 3</u> <b>Effectiveness of the plan</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does the plan work?</li> <li>• If it doesn't, what went wrong?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No</li> <li>• Friar Lawrence's letter doesn't get to Romeo.</li> <li>• A monk sees Benvolio who is racing to Mantua. Tried to stop him but Benvolio needs to tell Romeo of the news.</li> <li>• Because the letter doesn't get to Romeo, he believes she is dead and drinks poison to be with her.</li> <li>• Romeo's poison: clear glass bottle, clear liquid, tastes vile, bitter, stings throat</li> <li>• Juliet wakes, finding Romeo dead at her side. She takes her own life.</li> </ul>		
<u>Paragraph 4</u> <b>Lessons learnt/ Ending</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do Romeo and Juliet get their happy ending?</li> <li>• Have any of the characters learnt anything?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The hatred between the families, dies with Romeo and Juliet.</li> <li>• They are buried together.</li> <li>• Statue created with the words: '<i>There never was a story of more woe, Than this of Juliet and Romeo.</i>'</li> </ul>
