Day	Deed
Tuesday 22 September	Make someone smile.

Thursday 24 September	Secret Angel Game (Every child has a person in their class who they compliment and are kind to, but it's a secret and their secret angel is revealed at the end of the day).
Friday 25 September	Charity Day – please can you donate any old blankets, towels or bedding so we can donate to the RSPCA. There will be a box on the school gate for the children to leave their donations in.
Monday 28 September	Make a card for the residents of a care home. These will be laminated before being sent so they can be easily cleaned.
Tuesday 29 September	Help someone.
Wednesday 30 September	Can we create a foodbank to help people locally? Can we ask that you donate a tin or packet food that we can donate to a local food bank. There will be boxes outside of the entrances for your items.
Thursday 1 October	Play with someone that you do not know very well.
Friday 2 October	Let someone go in front of you in a line.
Monday 5 October	Tell someone why they are special to you.
