<b>Small Blues (Yr 1 only)</b>	Design your own front cover of your favourite traditional tale.	Create a fact file of your favourite fairy tale character.
<b>Holly Blues</b>	Work with grown-ups at home to research amazing facts about your favourite dinosaur.	Create a dinosaur mask or hat and bring it to school for a dinosaur parade!
<b>Adonis Blues</b>	Design a poster to show a volcano's main features. Make sure you label its important parts.	Imagine you have just survived an earthquake. Write a short story about what happened. Make sure you include factual information such as the earthquake's strength. Use geographical words in your account such as tremor, seismic isolator, aftershock and epicenter.
<b>Silver Studded Blues</b>	Make sketches of Tudor costumes for children and adults, rich and poor. Use websites and books to find out about garments, styles and decorative details.	Design a Tudor snakes and ladders-style board game, with pitfalls and lucky breaks on the way to freedom from the Tower of London!
