

## **MPA REMOTE LEARNING CONSENT FORM**

### **Information for Parents and Carers – Remote Learning**

Martlesham Primary Academy aims to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for every child or young person.

To help us do this, please note the following important information.

At, Martlesham Primary Academy, we understand the need to continually deliver high quality education, including during periods of remote learning – whether for an individual pupil or many. We recognise the importance of maintaining high expectations in all areas of school life and ensuring that all pupils have access to the learning resources and support they need to succeed.

Through the implementation of the Remote Learning Policy, we aim to address the key concerns associated with remote learning, such as online safety, access to educational resources, data protection, and safeguarding.

The Remote Learning Policy aims to:

- Minimise the disruption to pupils' education and the delivery of the curriculum.
- Ensure provision is in place so that all pupils have access to high quality learning resources.
- Protect pupils from the risks associated with using devices connected to the internet.
- Ensure staff, parent, and pupil data remains secure and is not lost or misused.
- Ensure robust safeguarding measures continue to be in effect during the period of remote learning.
- Ensure all pupils have the provision they need to complete their work to the best of their ability, and to remain happy, safe, and supported during periods of remote learning.

In order to deliver remote learning for your child all questions on the consent form must be completed and signed by the parent or carer to enable your child to continue to take part in remote learning lessons/activity.

## **Parent/Carer Consent**

I understand that my child needs to follow the behaviour code for Remote Learning lessons/activities and any safety rules so that Martlesham Primary Academy can keep them and other children safe.

I agree to:

- my child taking part in the Remote Learning provided by Martlesham Primary Academy, including during live online lessons.
- *Martlesham Primary Academy* keeping a record of this form for safeguarding and data protection.
- My child being recorded during the Remote Learning sessions, with recordings stored securely on the learning platform only to be referred to for safeguarding purposes or for re-sharing/re-capping previous learning with pupils.
- It is the responsibility of parents/carers to inform Martlesham Primary Academy in writing, if consent needs to be withdrawn or amended.

### **Parents and carers are responsible for:**

1. Adhering to the Remote Learning policy at all times during periods of remote learning.
2. Ensuring their child is able to learn remotely and that the schoolwork set is completed on time and to the best of their child's ability.
3. Checking the timetable for Remote Learning and make plans to complete the work by the end of the day.
4. Accessing the relevant resources.
5. Finding an appropriate place for your child to work, concentrate and try hard.
6. Making arrangements for their child to attend remote learning sessions/activities safely and on time. If a child is not able to attend the remote learning letting Martlesham Primary Academy know in advance.
7. Asking for help from teachers, either via Teams or the School Office.
8. Informing Martlesham Primary Academy if your child is unwell and therefore cannot complete their work.
9. Informing the teacher immediately if they have any concerns related to the safety of the remote learning.
