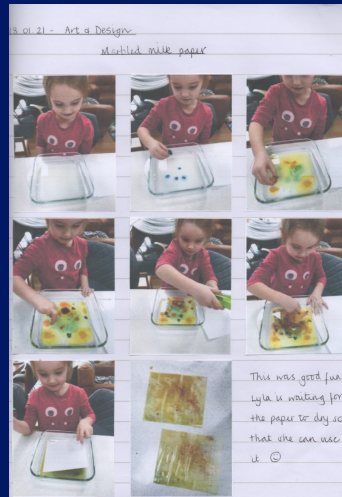


**RECEPTION: FLORENCE**

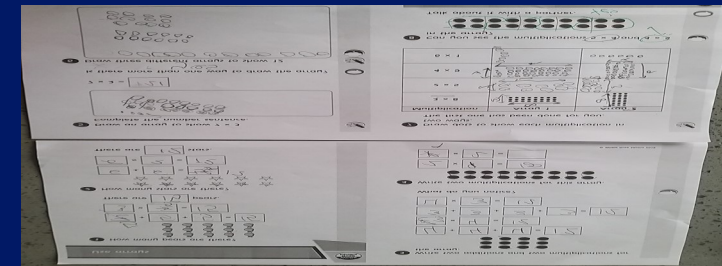


This week Small Blues were authors and wrote their own Naughty Bus story. Florence wrote and illustrated her story and then sent in a video of her reading her story.

Isla has worked very hard all week learning to multiply. She has made really good progress in her times tables.

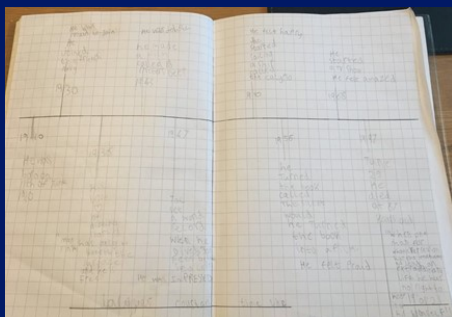
**YEAR 3: JACK GS**

Jack found out who Jacques Cousteau was and his achievements. He started by creating a timeline of his life and then added extra details and quotes.



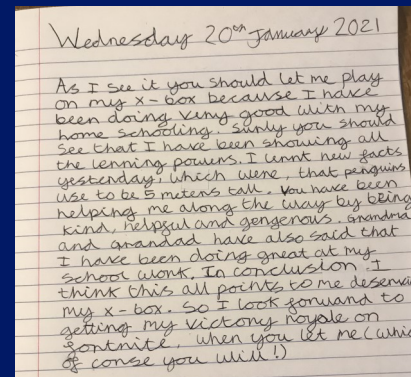
**YEAR 4: BRODY**
