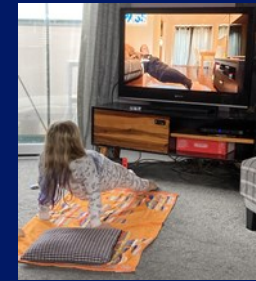
### YEAR 1: YOTA
