

## Literacy

In Literacy we will continue to develop our ability to use phonics independently during a variety of purposeful writing experiences including stories, fact files and poems.

## Understanding the World

This term we will be learning about the eco-systems, food chains and habits that are found in the sea. We will learn about the life cycle of a turtle.

We will explore the properties of materials and investigate what the best material is to make a raincoat.

This term we will explore coastal and underwater environments, building on our skills of being able to identify man-made and natural features. We will name and identify the different oceans.

We will learn about the life of Grace Darling and exploring the differences between seaside towns in the past and present.

# Reception Under the Sea



## RE

This term we will investigate the questions 'What makes every single person precious and unique?' and 'How can we care for our wonderful world?'

## Maths

In Maths this term we will explore place value and number, progressing to recognising, writing and using numbers to 20. We will be adding and subtracting as well as measuring length, weight and capacity.

## Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will study seascapes by famous artists and explore different techniques to represent ocean waves including collage and printing.

We will begin to explore sculpture and use clay to create sea creatures.

## PE

The children will begin by developing their skills of running, throwing and jumping. During the second half of the term the learning focus will be on the skills of co-operation, sharing, listening and turn taking in team games.
