Please find attached the home learning ideas for your child's theme for this term. These two pieces of compulsory home learning will have a due date and will be expected to be handed in by this date. **This home learning can be handed in on Teams via the assignment, on Tapestry or as a physical copy in school.**

Class	Due date: Wednesday 19 May	Due date: Wednesday 7 July
<b>Small Blues (Yr 1 only)</b>	Make an 'Under the Sea' habitat. Make sure you think about animal and plant life.	Create a fact file about a native British under the sea creature. Share some facts that will wow and amaze us.
<b>Holly Blues</b>	Make a miniature seashore garden using natural materials, such as pebbles, twigs, sand and shells.	Write a poem about the living things that make their home in a rock pool. An acrostic or shape poem would be fun.
<b>Adonis Blues</b>	Use your knowledge of teeth to design and create an information poster, teaching other children how to look after their teeth and why it is important. Think about the important messages that you want to give about oral hygiene. Can you create a catchy slogan? You might like to include an idiom after learning about them in class.	Think about what you ate yesterday. Write a food diary, recording what you ate, whether the snack or meal was healthy or unhealthy and explain why.
<b>Silver Studded Blues</b>	Time to be creative!  Look out for heart shapes around you – in decorative ironwork, embellishments in clothing and jewellery, and even in nature itself. Photograph your findings and make a colourful montage.	Find out about some famous heart surgeons. What do you need to study to become a heart surgeon? How long would it take if you started right now? What skills and personality would make you successful in this role?  Make sure you present your ideas clearly.
