Birthdays

From The Catering Team

Children are selected by the catering team for their good manners and eating a good variety of foods. This includes packed lunch children as well. On a Friday the nominated children get a special plate, special cup with squash and their award. If a child is nominated that normally has packed lunch they get to choose a dessert from the dessert table. Friday is Fruity Friday whereby all children are allowed to help themselves to the fruit platter at lunch. Once the weather gets wet, children will need to bring in a change of shoes for outside so mud isn't brought into the school and ruin the flooring.
