COVID19 Update

From today the government guidance has changed. The update states anyone with a positive COVID19 test is advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for five days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice is three days. We are aware there is a shortage of LFT kits and will support families as much as possible. The guidance has also changed for home learning and we are no longer legally required to provide this to children isolating. If your child is off school but well enough for home learning we recommend completing the theme linked home learning tasks and the mandatory home learning set at the start of term. There is also Ed Shed or other online learning platforms.

We received home learning from 82.5% of pupils this week, with the deadline being on Wednesday. This is a core piece of learning for children and we encourage families to support pupils in completing the tasks on time.
