Dear Families,

As you know we are now in a National Lockdown for the next four weeks. Considering this there are some changes to school procedures and arrangements. We hope you appreciate these are in place to ensure the safety of our school community.

### Masks / Visors

School staff will wear visors on the playground in the mornings and the afternoons. Teaching staff are wearing visors when teaching in the classrooms. We are encouraging parents to wear masks/ face coverings when they enter the playground. If you need to go to the school office, then you do need to wear a mask / face covering when entering the building. The catering team are all wearing visors and gloves when supporting the children during lunchtime.

# After School Clubs

We are going to continue to run after school clubs that are provided by Inspire Suffolk during the next four weeks. We are going to offer an additional club for Key Stage Two on a Thursday. We are permitted to run clubs to support parents with childcare and for the children's mental and physical well-being. Ipswich School of Dance and Wildcats Football will resume once lockdown measures are lifted. The Inspire clubs are £2 per session and we ask that you pay in advance.
