

Forest School Clothing



Forest School sessions take place in all weathers except for unsafe conditions (e.g. high winds). The environment can present some exciting and challenging experiences such as snow, rain and muddy puddles. It is essential children are dressed appropriately throughout the year.

Children must have their legs covered at all times with trousers or leggings to help prevent tick bites and stings. We recommend children have a waterproof outer layer to wear all year round. Once the children are in wet clothing they can become cold very quickly, even in summer. If children are not dressed appropriately, then for health and safety reasons, they may not be able to participate in the sessions.
