Small Blues (Year 1 only)	Keep a night diary for a week, draw and label the different things you notice at night. You could look at the moon and how it changes, the constellations of stars and the wildlife that visits your garden.	Design and build a space buggy. Have a look at examples on the internet and then use junk modelling materials to make a vehicle that could drive on the surface of the moon.
Holly Blues	Write a list of adjectives to describe what spiders look like and a list of verbs to describe what spiders do. Use your word lists to write six sentences about spiders. Draw a diagram of a spider and label its features.	With an adult, use the internet to research amazing minibeasts found in other parts of the world, such as the Borneo walking stick or the Goliath beetle. Make an information poster to showcase the facts and information you find.

Adonis Blues	Create a project glossary of scientific terms. Write a definition for each of the words listed, using a dictionary to help.
