Blast from the Past

English

We will be writing recounts based on our Stunning Start as well as describing a range of artefacts. We will be exploring 'Wilfrid Gordon McDonald Partridge' and will be writing lists and using adjectives to describe different people. We will also be writing stories based on the book 'Lost in the toy museum'. We will also be writing a biography about Queen Elizabeth II.

Maths

We will begin by focussing on number and place value. We will then be learning different methods of addition and subtraction. We will also be learning about the properties of shape.

Design and Technology

We will be exploring shade and shelter. We will consider different materials and design and build our own shelters and dens.

RE

We will be learning about Christianity and Judaism.



Computing

We will be learning about basic algorithms, how to follow algorithms and how to devise a simple algorithm. We will also be learning to turn on and log onto the computers.

Music

We will be learning to listen to music, develop our musical knowledge and perform reggae, hip-hop and rap songs in different ways.

Geography

We will be learning about physical and human features. We will look at maps, use directional language and learn the compass points. We will also learn about the continents and oceans.

PE

The children will be working on multi-skills and spatial awareness. They will also learn dance through short stories.

Science

We will be learning about natural and human-made materials. We will be grouping their materials, observing their properties, and conducting scientific investigations. We will also learn about the human body, senses, and body parts. We will compare the human body to animals.

History

We will be learning about everyday life and families, childhood and comparing childhood today with the 1950s. We will also look at how places change over time.

Art and Design

We will be learning about primary and secondary colours, colour mixing and colour theory. We will describe artwork and begin to compare artwork. We will be creating our own pieces of artwork using colour. We will also explore portraits, using collage and will create our own self-portrait using collage. We will also learn to use stitching to join materials.
