Ed Shed

All children in Years 1 to 6 have access to Ed Shed to develop their spelling and maths skills. These are interactive games in line with what the children should be learning for their age. This platform can be accessed via most devices. Each week we reward the children who are the Ed Shed Champion in Spelling and Maths. We have also launched rewards for achieving points levels. Every million points earned equals one point in school and rewards are available for reaching 30, 60, 90, 120, 160 and 200 points. Sadly, this week only 25% of children accessed Ed Shed.
