Dear Parents,

Chalk Hill Blues Educational Visit: Tide Mill Museum, Woodbridge

As part of the theme, Misty Mountain, Winding River, Year 4 and 5 will be visiting the Woodbridge Tide Mill. During this visit, we will have a tour which will include discussions around the Deben River and how the Tide Mill utilises the river and its environment. We will also have some learning activities specifically created for our visit.

The visit will take place on Wednesday 8 March and we will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning to school at 3.00pm.

For this day, the children will need to wear school uniform but they can wear trainers. They will also need to bring a bag with their packed lunch and water bottle in it. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and you require a school packed lunch, please indicate this on the reply slip so this can be arranged.

The cost of the visit is £16.50 per child. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, please speak to the School Office if you would like to use this towards the cost. We recognise the higher cost of this educational visit, therefore this can be paid in two equal installments of £8.25 if this is more convenient for you, which will be available as an option on Arbor.

I am hoping the Woodbridge Tide Mill will be a memorable educational visit and I am very much looking forward to taking the children. We do require parent volunteers to support on this visit. Please indicate if you are able to offer your help on the reply slip.
