Bird Fat Ball Recipe (As promised)!

These can easily be made to help our feathered friends in the winter months.

Mixed wild bird seed
Oats
Dried Fruit
Lard

Make a hole in a clean yogurt pot and thread through some string. We lined our pots with nets from chocolate coins to make them slightly sturdier. Pack the above ingredients in and then carefully pour over melted lard – this part will need an adult. Leave the fat balls to set in the fridge and then gently prise them from the pots and hang in the garden.



Do not feed these to the birds during warm weather as the fat can melt and clog their feathers.
