We are carefully monitoring attendance. If your child's attendance falls below 96% you will receive a warning letter stating there is a concern and we will be monitoring. If attendance does not improve you will then get notification by letter stating the concerns we have. If there is no improvement then you will be asked to school for a meeting where we will plan next steps and identify what needs to happen to improve attendance. If there continues to be no improvement and your child's attendance is below 90% we will be involving the Education Welfare Officer. We know there are times of genuine illness and of course we are supportive. Currently, some families are taking holidays in term time and also children are having odd days off for colds etc.

Attendance below 96% really impacts on your child's progress.
