Privacy Notice

Your trust is very important to us. This means the BBC is committed to protecting the privacy and security of your/your child's personal data. It is important that you read this notice so that you are aware of how and why we are using such information. This privacy notice describes how we collect and use personal data about you and your child during and after your relationship with us, in accordance with data protection law. What will BBC collect and how will we use it?

The BBC will collect and process the following personal data about you/your child submitting your application including your child's name, age, date of birth, contact information, your address and review or submission. //The BBC is the "data controller" of your personal data. This means that the BBC decides what your personal data is used for, and the ways in which it is processed. For the avoidance of doubt, your personal data will be collected and processed solely for the purposes set out in this privacy notice. As the data controller, the BBC has the responsibility to comply, and to demonstrate compliance with, data protection law.

Retaining your data

We hope to use your/your child's creation/submission on a Blue Peter show, but we can't guarantee it. Submissions by post - If your child's badge application is successful, we'll retain your submission/creation for 12 weeks. Submissions by the Uploader - If your child's badge application is successful, we'll retain your submission for 12 months. The BBC will retain your child's personal data for the purpose of the Badge Card system until they are 16 and a half years old. If your child's submission/image is used for broadcast, it will be retained within the broadcast and archived indefinitely by the BBC in the public interest.

Your rights and more information

You have **rights** under data protection law. You can **request a copy** of the personal data BBC stores about you. You have the right to ask for the personal data we collect about you to be **deleted** however there are limitations and exceptions to this right which may entitle the BBC to refuse your request. In certain circumstances, you have the right to **restrict** the processing of your personal data or to **object** to the processing of your personal data. You have the right to ask that we **transfer** the personal data to you or to another organisation, in certain circumstances.
