Years 3, 5 and 6 visit to The New Wolsey Theatre

Years 3, 5 and 6 will be visiting The New Wolsey Theatre for Michael Rosen's Big 50 Years Show on Thursday 7 March 2024 (World Book Day). Michael Rosen will be performing live on stage, marking the 50th anniversary of his first book for children, *Mind Your Own Business* and 50 years of Michael inspiring generations of children, teachers and families with his poetry and live performances. This special performance will also be livestreamed to schools around the country. The children will also receive a copy of Michael Rosen's book 'Big Book of Bad Things' as they leave the theatre for them to keep. Michael Rosen is an author and poet who is frequently referred to within education and the children also show great enthusiasm and excitement towards his work. We hope this performance will inspire them further in their writing and their love of poetry!

The children will be leaving school at 12.30pm and returning for approximately 3.00pm. They will be able to have their usual choice of lunch in school this day as they will eat before leaving.
