

English

The children will be writing for a range of purposes this term based around their theme, including narrative, non-fiction and poetry. They will also be reading Boudica's Army and completing a range of activities based on this text.

Design and Technology

The children will explore machines, mechanisms, and different shaped cams. This will lead into designing and making an automaton toy. They will also about the purpose, structure and design features of greenhouses and then make one.

Science

The children will learn and investigate about plants. They will investigate from plant vessels, life cycles to seed dispersal. What's more, they will learn about light and dark, shadows and reflections.

Geography

The children will learn to name, locate, and describe different counties and cities in the UK. They will investigate how carbon footprints can be reduced to how the weather affects our local area.

PSHE

The children will learn about the roles that different people take within our community. They will also learn about first aid and how families can be different from one another; recognising all types of families.



Emperors and Empires

PE

The children will be working on a range of athletic skills as a group and individually within a variety of team games, striking and fielding.

RE

The children will be studying aspects of Judaism and Christianity this term.

French

The children will have the knowledge and skills to be able to say which fruits they like and do not like. Also, to be familiar with fairy tale recounted in the foreign language of 'Little Red Riding Hood'.

Maths

The children will be learning about the Internet and World Wide Web within the unit, iConnect. They will create and edit audio podcasts in the unit, iPodcast.
