#### English

The children will be writing for a range of purposes this term based around their theme, including narrative, non-fiction, such as a newspaper report and poetry. They will also be reading 'Goodnight Mister Tom' by Michelle Magorian and completing a range of activities based on this text.

#### <u>Science</u>

The children will investigate properties of materials. They will also investigate solubility as well as sieving, filtration and evaporation to separate mixtures. Finally, they will consider reversible and irreversible changes.

#### Geography

The children will develop their skills in analysis of data about human geography in the world. They will compare three capital cities around the world before considering the relative location of different places and the purpose of motorways in the UK. Finally, they will consider different settlement types before investigating a local settlement.

# Computing

History The children will continue to develop their programming skills, creating a computer game on Kodu. They will also learn how to use 3D modelling tools to create graphic models.

The children will continue to develop their improvisation skills, exploring the freedom this brings. They will also develop their performance skills using their own choice of music.

# French

Music

The children will be learning about school, including different subjects as well as providing their own opinions. They will also learn about other countries in the world that speak French.

# RE

The children will be studying aspects of Christianity, considering the significance of the 'Eucharist' to Christians, and Buddhism, considering how Buddhists believe they can find enlightenment, this term.

#### Maths

This term, Year 5develop their knowledge and understanding of shape, position and direction, negative numbers and converting units. Year 6 children will develop their knowledge and understanding of angles in different shapes, position and direction and

After learning about wars across history that Britain has been involved in, they will learn about the causes of WW2, considering the impact on everyday life for civilians. They will also consider the significance of technology in WW2 as well as different leaders' decisions. They will decide whether the Battle of Britain was a turning point and explore the involvement of Martlesham Airfield in WW2.

Across the term, the children will learn about abstract art and Orphism, creating a final piece inspired by music. They will also develop their sketchbook use, observational drawing and mixed media collage.
