After School Clubs - Autumn Term 2024

We are reducing our MPA club offer to support Premier Education.

For Premier Education, you will need to book using a link, which they will provide later in the week This needs to be paid in advance.

Thursday	KS2 Art and Design Club with Miss Markham.	£3.00	Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 (20 Children) Pupil Premium can attend for free.
Thursday	Commercial Dance with Miss Bobbie.	£4.00	All years Pupil Premium can attend for free.

All clubs will start from **Monday 9 September** and will run until **Thursday 20 December** from 3.15pm to 4.15pm.

From October Half Term, there will be a free Netball Club at lunchtime for Years 4, 5 and 6.

With the exception of Premier Sport Clubs, If your child wishes to take part in any of the above clubs, you will need to register them by logging onto Arbor. The booking system will go live on **Tuesday 16 July @ 4.00pm** and will close on **Monday 9 September @ 9.00am**.

School club places are limited to 20 children per club. We will be offering these places on a first come, first served basis. Just to clarify, until you have paid for your child's club, their place will not be confirmed.

If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, you can use your allocation towards the cost of these clubs. Please still log into Arbor to book your child's place and we will arrange payment for you.
