English

We will be writing for a range of purposes based around the theme, including narrative, non-fiction and poetry. We will be reading 'The Iron Man' by T Hughes and 'Stone Age Boy' by S Kitamura and completing activities based on these texts.

<u>Maths</u>

Our focus will be on number within maths, concentrating on refining and furthering the children's skills in place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will apply these skills in both arithmetic and reasoning.

Design and Technology

Using the 'Eatwell' Guide, pupils will learn about different food groups; types of cooking and explore these by cooking potatoes, ratatouille and a taco filling according to specific design criteria.

RE

We will be learning about Islam and Christianity.

French

We will be learning greetings and different animals.

PE

The children will be working on a range of ball skills, invasion games, teamwork games and gymnastics.

<u>Art and Design</u>

Pupils will explore colour, create their own cave paintings using charcoal, chalk and ochre. We will explore different clay techniques which pupils will use to make and decorate their own 'Bell Beaker' pot.

History

We will be learning about
British prehistory from the Stone
Age through to the Bronze
Age and Iron Age including
changes to people and
lifestyle caused by ingenuity,
invention and technological
advancement. We will create
timelines to help us understand
the order in which these eras
of history took place.

Computing

The children will be learning about programming, animations and simulations.

Science

We will learn about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals.
We will focus on the role of the skeleton and muscles and identify animals with different types of skeleton.

Geography

Learn to locate key cities and countries across the world and use grid references, compass points and latitude and longitude. We will learn about the layers of the earth and plate tectonics and discover the five major climate zones. They will develop geographical skills through carrying out fieldwork to discover how land is used locally in and around the Martlesham area.

Music

Year 3 will be having weekly guitar lessons to aid development of listening, appraising, playing and performance skills.
