

The children at MPA have enjoyed wonderful key texts during this term!





In Silver Studded Blues, they have read 'Pig Heart Boy'.



In Royal Blues, they have read 'Cosmic'.


Connie Y5—I enjoyed it because it was all about space and that interests me.


Rose Y5—I really enjoyed it because there are a lot of cliffhangers and you don't know what will happen next.



Kaleib Y5—I really liked when they got lost up in space and Eddie Xanadu's son went missing!













In Chalk Hill Blues, they have read 'How To Train Your Dragon'.


Alby Y4—I enjoyed the story because there were a lot of funny words when they were shouting.


Beau Y4—I liked that there was a lot of characters. Hiccup was my favourite because he was the bravest and had to keep going!















In Adonis Blues, they have read 'The Iron Man'.


Ayla Y3 — The best thing about the Iron Man was when he got trapped in the hole because Hogarth helped him out.
















In Holly Blues, they have read 'The Paper Dolls'.


Felix Y2—I liked when the dolls were snipped up because it was funny!

Edie Y1—I liked that she made the paper dolls and they were her friends.












In Small Blues, one of the books they have read is Jesus' Christmas Party.


Lottie EYFS—I loved the ending and how the innkeeper looked at the baby.





Finn EYFS—I liked the start because it was a bit silly. It was night, he was sleeping and a knock woke him up!

The children have been enjoying the library this term, and new library leaders are in post to open this up two lunchtimes a week.


