Think HAF; Think Eequ! Everything you need to know about Eequ booking platform

- HAF codes used to be used – HAF codes are now no longer given to schools/parents or needed to book places
- The website Eequ is the place to find out more about what is on offer and to book places www.eequ.org/suffolkhaf and QR code ----->
- You can search for a programme on the search bar or you can click 'Show Map' to see the programmes available – you can zoom into the area you live to find your nearest programme(s)
- Once you find a programme you like, you will be invited to go to full details and booking
- When booking, the website will ask you about how you are eligible – e.g. receive free school meals, child is a young carer, has a EHC plan etc
- The booking goes to Suffolk County Council first to check that you are eligible – then it goes to the provider to confirm the booking; it can take a few days for the booking to be confirmed
- Eligibility for this includes those who are on Free School Meals, assessed to be in need by local authority, young carer, looked after child, come from a low income households and not in receipt of free school meals, on an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- Private spaces can be purchased on programmes on Eequ too
