It was a fantastic event with the children showing enthusiasm and an enjoyment of performance poetry.



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








At MPA, we have read exciting texts linked to our themes this term.





In Small Blues, one of the books they have read is 'Elmer'.

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
Layla EYFS—I liked the bit where he decorates himself. I liked when he got covered in blackberry juice.

Mary-Kate EYFS—I liked the rainbow on his body.




In Holly Blues, they have read 'Queen Victoria's Bathing Machine' by Gloria Whelan.

Ayla Y2— I liked that she had lots of children and that her husband made the bathing machine.




Caiden Y2—I liked that it was a funny story!




Emilia Y1—I liked when Prince Albert made the bathing machine so Queen Victoria could get changed in it.


They also read 'The Queen's Knickers' by Nicholas Allan.

Darcie-Mae Y1—I liked that she had all sorts of knickers and it was really colourful!










In Adonis Blues, they have read 'Boudica's Army' by Hilary McKay.



Nojus Y3—I like how the book has a cliffhanger at the end because it doesn't have a second book to explain the ending, so I can think of all the things that could happen next.


Charlie Y3—I like the book because it is fun to learn more about Queen Boudica and her army.

Alessandra Y3—I liked how the book linked to our history lessons, about her significant actions.










In Chalk Hill Blues, they have read 'Secrets of a Sun King' by Emma Carroll.


Gracie Y4—I have enjoyed the story because it has cliffhangers which leave you wanting to read the next chapter.




Ella-Rose Y4—I have enjoyed the book because when I grow up, I want to be an archaeologist and the story has helped give me extra information towards this dream.
