

## Maths

This term we will be learning about multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and percentages, perimeter and area and statistics. We will also continue to recap prior learning through our 'Flashback 4' questions daily and we will continue to develop our times tables recall.

## Geography

Our topic this half term is Sow, Grow and Farm. This project teaches children about the features and characteristics of land use in agricultural regions across the world, including a detailed exploration of significant environmental areas.

## PSHE

Our focus in PSHE before half term is Online Safety. We will be understanding how to use the internet safely and recognise any dangers. In Spring 2, we will be focussing on First Aid and Head Injuries. We will be understanding how to treat different types of injury and perform basic first aid.

## RE

In RE this term, we will be learning about Hinduism and Judaism. We have two key questions which we will be exploring.

## Science

In Science this term, our unit of work links to Sow, Grow and Farm. We will be learning about human reproduction and aging. This project teaches children about animal life cycles, including the human life cycle. They explore human growth and development to old age, including the changes experienced during puberty and human reproduction.

## Music

Our two units of music this term will be focussing on the song 'Make You Feel My Love' and 'The Fresh Prince Of Bel-Air'.

## Computing

Our unit in spring 1 is called 'iCrypto'. We will be learning about communicating securely over distances. After half term, our unit is 'iWeb'. We will be looking into the internet and creating webpages.

## French

Our first unit is called Chez moi (my home). This includes rooms and where we live in French. After half term, we will be understanding clothes in French.

## Design and Technology

This project is linked to Sow, Grow and Farm. This project teaches children about the meaning and benefits of seasonal eating, including food preparation and cooking techniques. The children will design and make a healthy soup.

## English

Our key text this term is 'Where the World Turns Wild' written by Nicola Penfold. We will be reading the book during shared reading sessions and we will have many discussions about the text. In writing, we will be writing for a range of purposes including: to describe and narrate, to explain, to report and to entertain through poetry. We will build on prior learning and learn new writing skills too. Weekly spellings will be updated to spelling shed throughout the term.

## Art and Design

Before half term, we will be learning about 'line, light and shadow'. The children will explore the work of Pablo Picasso and Rembrandt. After half term, our unit is called 'Nature's Art'. We will do some work outdoors to sketch natural forms and explore the sculptural potential of natural materials before working collaboratively to create land art installations.

## PE

This term we will be deep diving into handball. The children will look at rules, skills and teamwork.
