#### Ed Shed

Although we have launched TT Rockstars, we are still encouraging the children to use Ed Shed. For Maths this covers a range of areas that the children learn. Also, spelling is a basic skill that we need to practice. So please encourage your child to complete their assignments.

#### Forest School

Our Forest School lead starts after term and will be working on Fridays. Can you ensure your child wears the correct Forest School clothes please. These need to cover arms and legs and have waterproofs. Wellies will need to be named and in school. Small Blue Class will need to wear uniform on Thursdays.

#### <u>PE Change</u>

After half term we need to make two PE changes for one week only. Year 4 will have PE on Wednesday and Year 5 on Friday please. This is for the first week back only. Usual timetable will resume the following week.

#### Reading Diaries

We have made our approach to checking reading diaries more consistent. Your child's reading diary is checked on a Friday with the number of reads recorded and new books are given (if required) and recorded in the diary. From next half term, children will receive 1 house point for 3 reads in a week and 2 house points for more than 3 reads. They will also continue to receive their end of term reward if they have consistently read 3 times or more each week of the term.

#### Parking Next Door

The white building next to school is going to be used by the Suffolk Music Service from Easter. The local authority have been in touch and said parents and staff are welcome to park in the car park at the back. However, they have asked that the front spaces are kept clear for their staff and visitors. Can I ask that after half term you do not use the spaces at the front of the building.
