We had a fantastic World Book Day at MPA on Thursday 6 March with a range of activities:

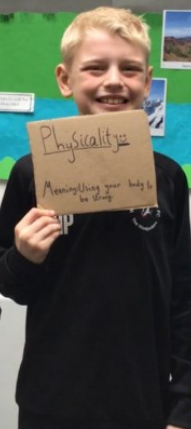
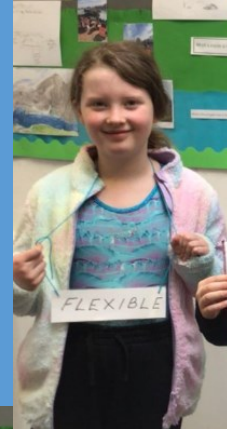
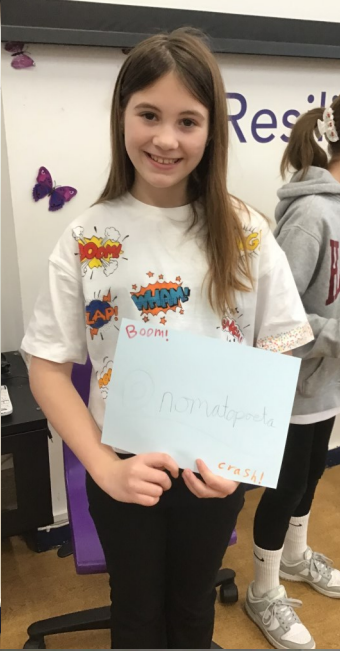
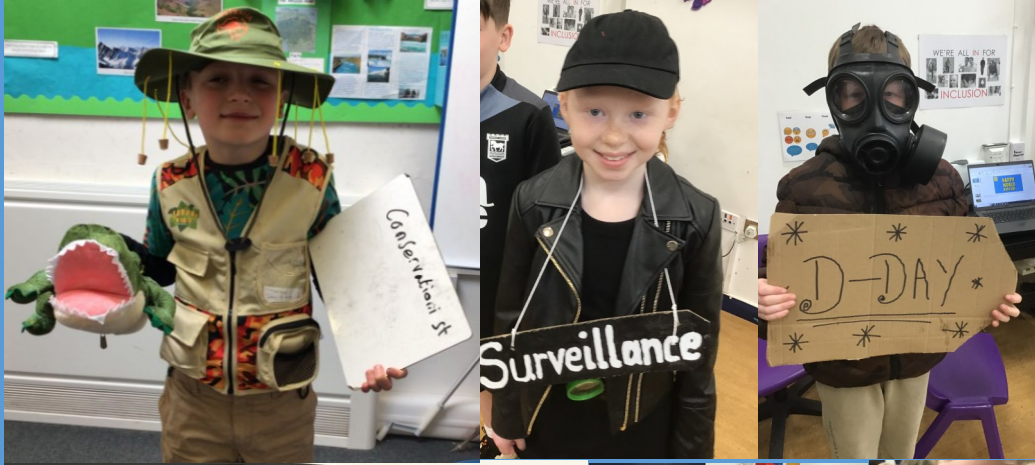
- We had a parade in the hall where we looked at everybody's 'word' outfits and learnt some new vocabulary!
