English

The children will be writing for a range of purposes this term based around their theme, including narrative, a non-fiction report on significant people in history, and poetry. They will also be reading 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram and 'Malala's Magic Pencil' by Malala Yousafzai.

Design and Technology

The children will learn about sources of food and tools used for food preparation. They will also discover why some foods are cooked and learn to read a simple recipe. The children will choose and make a new school meal using a criteria.

Science

This term, Holly Blues will explore what it takes for humans to survive and stay healthy. We will learn about the different stages of life and understand how our bodies grow and change over time. We will focus on the basic needs for survival, such as the importance of eating a balanced diet. Holly blues will also investigate how exercise helps keep us fit and supports our overall well-being. The topic of hygiene will be covered too.

<u>PE</u>

This term, we will be developing our athletic skills. We will also be playing games involving throwing and hitting.

Movers and Shakers –

Year 1 and 2

Geography

We will be naming and locating the four countries of the UK and their capital cities. We will also identify physical and human features in our local area and create picture maps. The children will use fieldwork to collect data on our local area to decide the type of settlement we live in.

PSHE

Holly Blues will complete the units 'What's the Risk?' and 'Safe Me'.



<u>History</u>

This term, we will be learning about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. We will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the significant people and use historical models to explore their significance.

RE

This term, the children will exploring prayer and worship in the Jewish faith and finding out why Christians pray to God and worship him.

Maths

We will start with recognising, counting and comparing amounts of money. Following this, we will be recognising and finding the fractions half, quarter, third and three-quarters and how to count fractions up to a whole. The second half term, we will be learning the months and days and how to tell the time. We will also measure and compare mass, capacity and volume and describe position and direction.

Computing

This term, we will learn how to create different projects using technology. We will explore how to add characters and use programming blocks to animate them on screen. Through hands-on activities, Holly Blues will dive into coding and computational thinking, discovering how to make their characters move and interact.

Art and Design

This term, we will be learning still life artwork. We will learn how to evaluate different areas of artwork and compare and contrast various artworks, highlighting the similarities and differences. Holly Blues will experiment with mixing colours to match those in famous paintings and create their own still life artwork

Music

This term we will be learning to sing, play, improvise and compose a song. We will also listen to and appraise friendship songs.
