# EYFS - Down the Bottom of the Garden Summer 1

## **Communication and Language**

In Small Blues, the children learn to name and identify foods that grow below the ground. They learn to describe how the same food can be cooked in different ways. They also learn to discuss how to care for the natural world around them.

## **Physical Development**

We will continue to build strength and control to help our pencil control.

In PE, the children will learn a variety of multi-sport skills and spatial awareness.

## Maths

The children will learn about numbers to 20 and beyond. They will learn to add and takeaway using the correct mathematical symbols and vocabulary.
