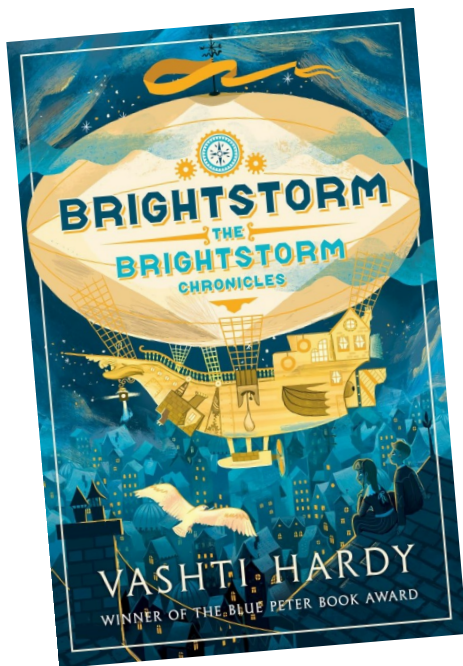

In Silver Studded Blues, they have read 'Brightstorm'.

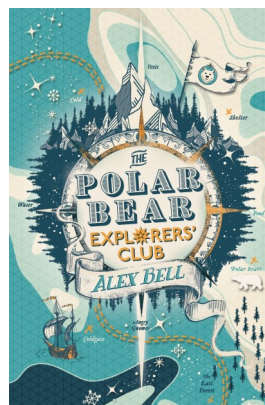
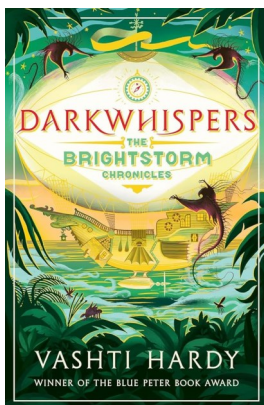

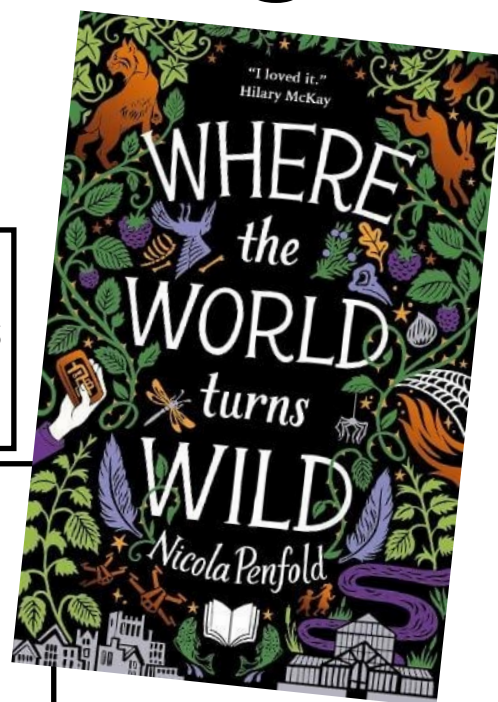

'Where the World Turns Wild'.

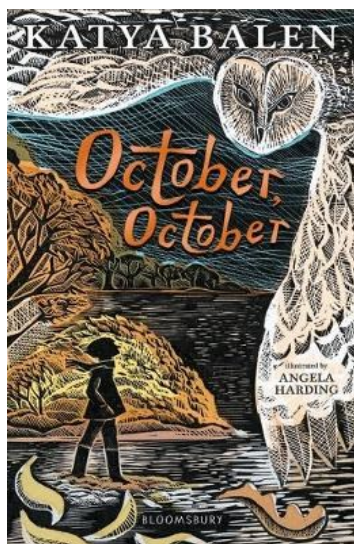
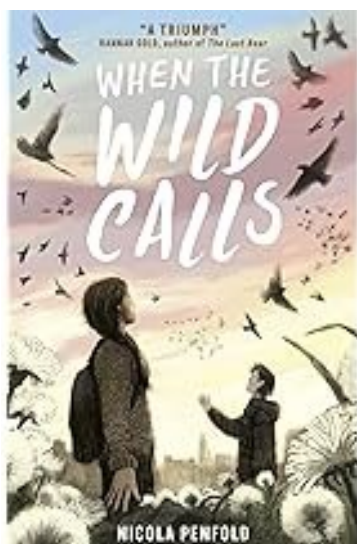
Ella-Rose Y5—My favourite character is Bear because he is really adventurous and he sticks up for himself.

Florence Y4—Durga is the God of the mountain.

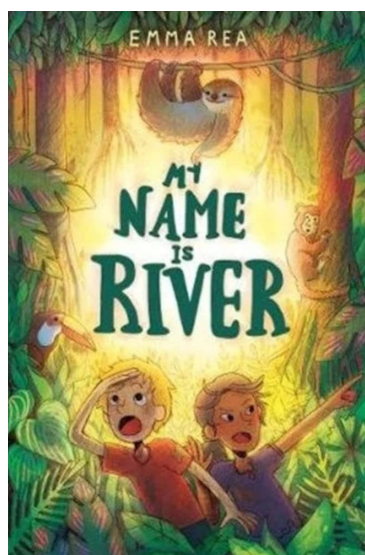
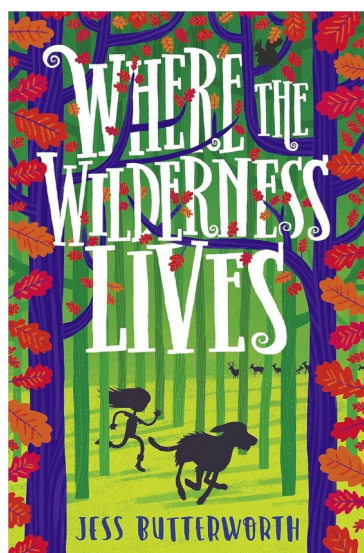
A tree was set on fire in the village and

on the way and I liked this part.

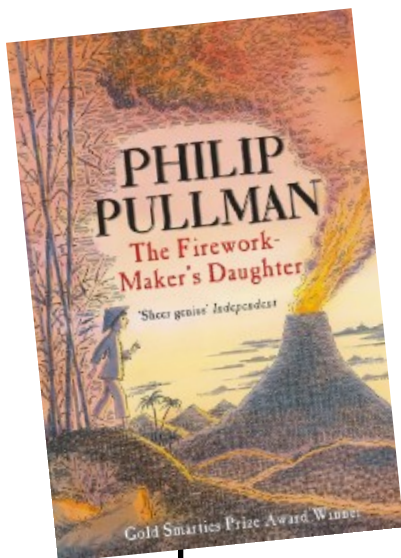
Cherish Y4—My favourite part was the same as Florence

In Adonis Blues, they have read 'The Firework Maker's Daughter'.

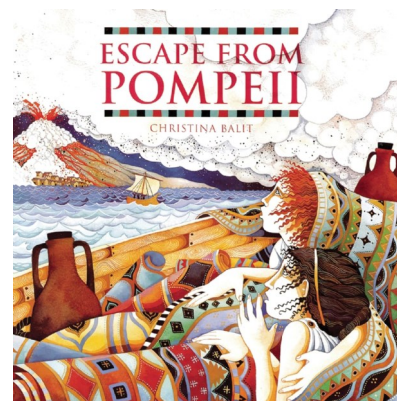
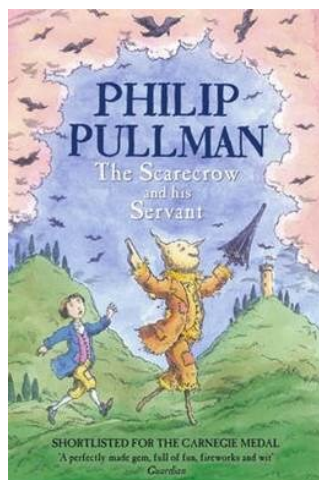
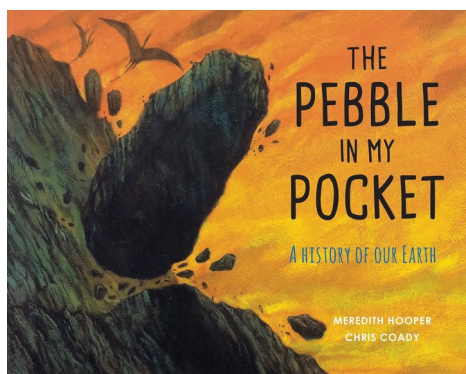
Deniz Y3—My favourite part was when Lila became a Firework Maker because she didn't know about the three gifts or Royal Sulphur and she actually had them the whole time.

Emilia Y2—I liked it when they squeezed the lion on the London Eye because it was funny.

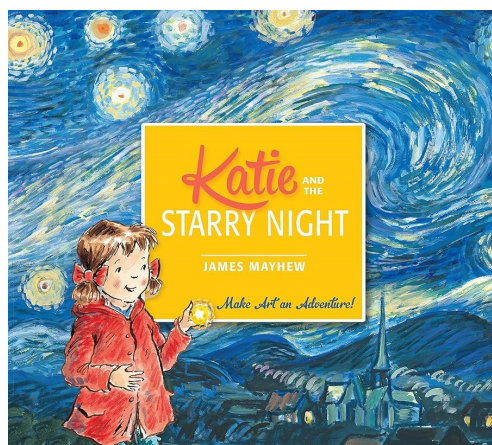
Isaac Y2—I thought the whole book was interesting especially when the lion came alive.

Darcey C—My favourite part of the story was when the fox is in London and he doesn't like the rain.

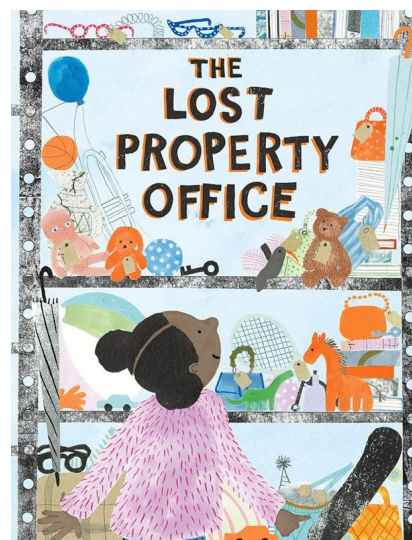
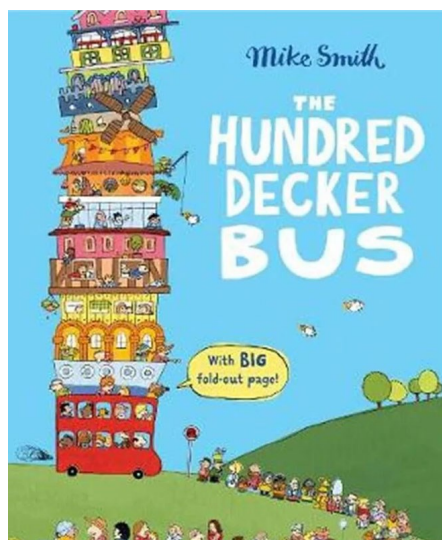
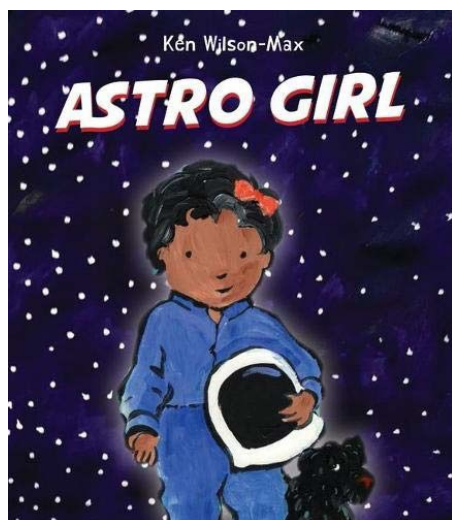


Archie—My favourite part was when the lion comes to life in Venice and roars on the plane.

At the start of the term, we had our reward event for those children who had read three times every week at home during the Autumn Term.

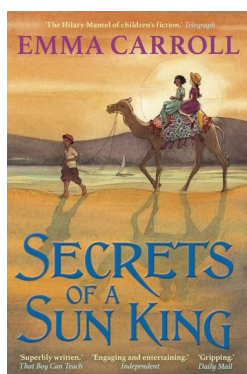

I like Cosmic because I always wondered what it is like up in space. I look up at the stars with my mom and they are beautiful. The book is very funny and I really enjoyed it.

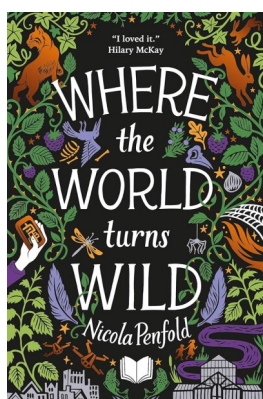
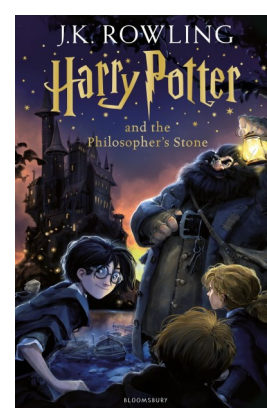


Astro Chimp—Hazel Y5
