Please ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather. They will need:

- a packed lunch (if you are providing your own)

The cost of the visit is **£19.20 per child**. We appreciate that this is higher than we would like; this is due to small class numbers and coach costs. We are offering the option to pay in two instalments via Arbor, with the final payment due by **3 March**. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium funding and you would like to use this to cover the cost of the trip, please indicate this on the reply slip.
