Dear Parents,

Silver Studded Blues Educational Visit: Sea Life Centre, Great Yarmouth

As part of the theme, Frozen Kingdom, Year 6 will be visiting the Sea Life Centre in Great Yarmouth. During this visit, we will have a VIP tour which will include discussions around the sea animals which live in the polar regions and their habitats as well as how animals have adapted to suit these environments. We will also have time to go back to areas which interested us during the tour and explore further at our own pace.

The visit will take place on Wednesday 4 March and we will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning to school at 3.45pm, traffic dependent.

For this day, the children will need to wear school uniform but they can wear trainers. They will also need to bring a bag which has their packed lunch and water bottle in it. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and you require a school packed lunch, please complete the menu attached and return to the school office to order this by Friday 20 February so this can be arranged.

The cost of the visit is £18.70 per child. Please pay for this on Arbor, where you can also consent for this visit by Friday 27 February. This can be paid in two installments of £9.35 if you prefer. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, please speak to the School Office if you would like to use this towards the cost.

We would greatly appreciate any parent volunteers to support on this visit. Please inform the school office if you are able to offer your help and you will be contacted to confirm whether we require your support, depending on how many volunteers there are.

The Sea Life Centre is always a memorable educational visit and I am very much looking forward to taking the children.
