

EYFS - Everyday Superheroes

Spring 1

Communication and Language

In Small Blues, the children learn who to ask for in they need help. They will use and understand the words, safe and safety. We will be learning about the key roles of people who help us, such as police officers, firefighters, dentists, doctors and vets .

Physical Development

We will continue to build strength and control to help our pencil control. In PE, the children will learn a variety of multi-sport skills and spatial awareness.

Maths

The children will continue to develop an understanding that all numbers are made up of smaller numbers and explore the composition of numbers up to 10.

We will also explore mass and capacity.

Understanding the World

We will learn about past and present and begin to compare how life has changed, we will compare objects such as fire engines.

PSED

This term, the children will be able to talk about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society.



Writing We will be continuing to learn how to write sentences. We will use our phonic knowledge to write words and begin to use finger spaces, full stops and capital letters when writing.

At the beginning of the term, we will be thinking about a time that we were brave, we will be discussing how we conquered this fear and achieved a goal.

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about 3D shape. We will begin to recognise and identify different 3D shapes and find them in the environment around us. We will continue to develop knowledge of numbers and start to learn our number bonds to 10.

Understanding the World

This term the children will be exploring maps and how we can identify the sea and the land.

Communication and Language

This term the children will be discussing the different journeys they have taken. They will be describing the journeys using positional language such as left and right.

Physical Development

We will continue to develop our fine and gross motor skills throughout our PE lessons and in the classroom.

Writing We will continue to build on our sentence writing, learning about sentence structures. The children will also be rewriting familiar stories creating adaptations to make stories their own.

Reading We will use a key text each week throughout our topic, the children will retell the stories, build on their comprehension skills and learn new vocabulary from the texts.
